



## HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES

### REFOCUS 2022 VACCINATION POLICY

Both ACLI and SOA continue to monitor the situation related to [Coronavirus \(COVID-19\)](#) to ensure the safety and security of attendees at our conferences. We are working closely with Aria Resort & Casino, Las Vegas to ensure that best practices are in place throughout every step of our meeting. ACLI's healthy and safety protocol is to follow CDC guidelines as well as state, local and hotel/host location guidelines.

As of **October 22, 2021**, CONFERENCE GUIDELINES FOR REFOCUS 2022 ATTENDEES ARE AS FOLLOWS\*:

- As part of our commitment to the safety at ACLI's ReFocus 2022, **all attendees will be required to be fully vaccinated** (i.e., at least two weeks after receiving the Johnson & Johnson shot or the 2<sup>nd</sup> Moderna, Pfizer or AstraZeneca shot) **and provide proof of vaccination. In lieu of proof of vaccination, we will also permit proof of a negative COVID test taken within 72 hours of the conference.**
- **Mask Mandate\***: The current status for Las Vegas (Clark County) requires everyone, *including fully vaccinated individuals*, to wear a mask in public indoor settings.
- Attendees are advised to stay home if you are feeling unwell or stay in your hotel room should you experience any symptoms after your arrival in Las Vegas.  
*\*These guidelines may change from time to time as conditions change. Attendees will be notified in advance of the conference of any changes to the conference guidelines.*

### NOTIFICATIONS:

In the event a conference attendee tests positive, ACLI will provide notification through our conference mobile app and email. We will also work with the Hotel to notify Southern Nevada Health department officials who may initiate contact tracing.
